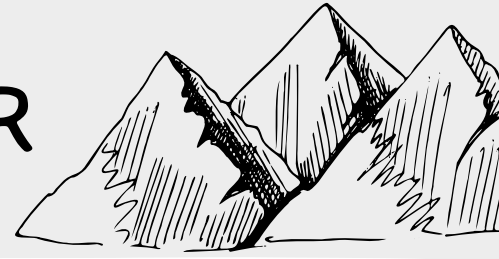

IMPORTANT INFO

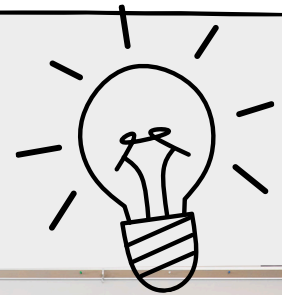

School Halloween Costumes

Approved School Costumes:

-  Shorts and skirts go below fingertips.
-  Shoulder straps must be 2 adult fingers wide.
-  Shirt covers midriff (tummy) with arms up.
-  Shoes are appropriate for recess and PE.
-  Costume is worn over real school clothes.
-  All students will participate in all school activities including PE.

NOT Approved School Costumes:

-  No blood, guts, or fake body parts
-  No weapons of any kind! (knives, guns, swords, fake fingernails)
-  No inflatable costumes or props. (Anything you need to hold on to or carry around)
-  Nothing covering face. (masks or make up.)
-  NO dead characters. (Zombies, Mummies, Vampires, dead people, etc...)
-  No acting out characters in school or on playground.
